

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to DE Section's letter of even number dated 21.06.2017, followed by corrigendum notice dated 28.06.2017, vide which the result of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (66.66%) for promotion to the cadre of Inspector Posts for the year 2015-16 (01.01.2015 to 31.03.2016), held on 22nd & 23rd October, 2016 in 18 Circles, was declared.

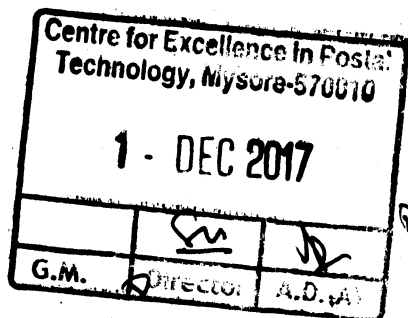
2. The Competent Authority has directed to grant "Qualified Status" to the APS candidates, who had been declared qualified in Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (66.66%) for promotion to the cadre of Inspector Posts for the year 2015-16 (01.01.2015 to 31.03.2016) held on 22nd & 23rd October, 2016, however, they had not been placed in merit list.
3. Accordingly, Name of the APS candidates granted "Qualified Status" from each Circle under relaxed standards mentioned in letter No. 7-14/2009-SPB-II dated 09.09.2015 issued by Personnel Division of the Directorate is appended hereby as Annexure-I.
4. It is further intimated here that the APS candidates qualified from Uttar Pradesh Circle has not been considered for granting them Qualified Status as the result of one candidate against UR vacancy of Uttar Pradesh has been kept on hold being provisional.
5. It is also to bring the fact in knowledge of all the concerned that APS candidates qualified in the afore-said exam from Gujarat Circle, Kerala Circle, Punjab Circle & Uttarakhand Circle have not come in the zone of 90% of the total marks secured by last candidate selected on merit in their parent Circle (in civil side) in the respective category. Himachal Pradesh Circle has not any candidate selected from civil side in the afore-said exam. Also, no APS candidate from North East Circle has appeared in the afore-said examination.
6. The Heads of Circles are requested to circulate the annexed list of APS candidates to the all concerned and also to take necessary action, if any.


