

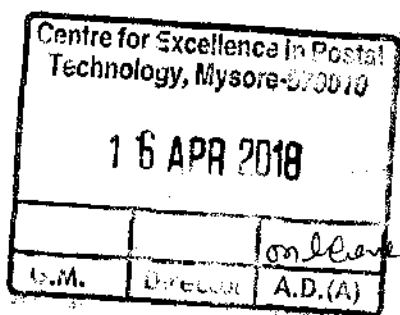
4. If the officer was on leave on 01.10.2012, the actual financial benefits of promotion will be effective from the date of joining after such leave.
