Subject: Appointment of Postal Assistant / Sorting Assistant candidate (matriculate Ex-Servicemen) selected on the basis of Combined Higher Secondary Level (CHSL) Examination, 2016-reg.

Sir,


I am directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and to state that the queries have been received in the Directorate seeking clarification as to whether a matriculate Ex-Serviceman who has put in not less than 15 year of service in the Armed Forces (Army, Navy or Air Force) of the Union and posses a Special Certificate issued by the Armed Forces certifying the said position will be eligible for the post of Postal Assistant / Sorting Assistant selected on the basis of Combined Higher Secondary Level Examination 2016.

2. In this connection, Staff Selection Commission (SSC) *vide* letter No. 3/4/2015-P&P-I(Pt-II) dated 05.02.2018 (*copy enclosed*) convey its decision in consultation with M/o HRD; which *inter alia* provides that

A matriculate Ex-Servicemen (which term includes an Ex-Servicemen, who has obtained the Indian Army Special Certificate of Education or the corresponding certificate in the Navy or the Air Force), who has put in not less than 15 years of service in the Armed forces of the Union is eligible for all the reserved posts advertised under CHSLE except for Data Entry Operator Grade 'A' in the Office of Comptroller and Auditor General of India

3. In view of the above, all Postal Circle are requested to bring the provisions of this OM to notice of all appointing authority.

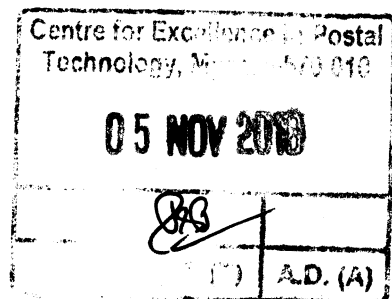

Subject: Eligibility of the candidates in Combined Higher Secondary Level Examination conducted by SSC-Reg

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and to state that the queries have been received in the Commission seeking clarifications as to whether the candidates having following qualifications are eligible for the posts advertized through Combined Higher Secondary Level (10+2) Examination or not, since minimum qualification for the said posts is 12th Standard Pass or equivalent Examination:

- (a) A candidate, without passing the 10+2 examinations, has obtained a Graduation Degree directly through Distance Learning Education Mode from a recognized University.
- (b) A Matriculate Ex-Servicemen, who has put in not less than 15 years of service in the Armed Forces of the Union and possess a Special Certificate issued by the Army, Navy or Air Force certifying the said position.

2. The matter was examined in the Commission in consultation with M/o HRD and has decided that:

- (i) Candidates possessing Degrees obtained through Distance Learning Education Mode from recognised Open University System are eligible for all the posts advertised under CHSLE, except for Data Entry Operator Grade 'A' in the Office of Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
- (ii) A matriculate Ex-Servicemen (which term includes an Ex-Servicemen, who has obtained the Indian Army Special Certificate of Education or the corresponding

certificate in the Navy or the Air Force). who has put in not less than 15 years of service in the Armed forces of the Union is eligible for all the reserved posts advertised under CHSLE except for Data Entry Operator Grade 'A' in the Office of Comptroller and Auditor General of India.

- (iii) For Data Entry Operator Grade 'A' in the Office of Comptroller and Auditor General of India, (CHSLE, 2016 onwards), since there is a specific EQ requirement of 12th standard pass in Science stream with Mathematics as a subject from a recognised board or equivalent, candidates at (i) and 2 (ii) above are not eligible for this post.
3. This issues with the approval of the Commission.
