
Sir/Madam,

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. (E) :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Department of Posts (Multi Tasking Staff) Recruitment Rules, 2018, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Department of Posts (Multi Tasking Staff) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Department of Posts (Multi Tasking Staff) Recruitment Rules, 2018, in the Schedule, :-

(A) in Part-I, under column (7), for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“(i) 10th standard pass from a recognized Board.

(ii) Knowledge of local language of the concerned Postal Circle or Division. The candidate should have studied local language at least upto 10th standard. The local language of a Postal Circle or Division shall be as published by the Department of Posts.

(iii) No educational qualification is prescribed for direct recruitment of Casual Labourer and Gramin Dak Sevak.”;

(B) in Part-II, under column (7), for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“(i) 10th standard pass from a recognized Board.

(ii) Knowledge of local language of the concerned Postal Circle or Division. The candidate should have studied local language at least upto 10th standard. The local language of a Postal Circle or Division shall be as published by the Department of Posts.

(iii) No educational qualification is prescribed for direct recruitment of Casual Labourer and Gramin Dak Sevak.”.
