SUPPLEMENTARY RESULT OF COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT OF GDS TO POSTMAN/ MAIL GUARD CADRE HELD ON 29.09.2019

This is in continuation of this office memo. no. ADR/CON/1-12/2019-Pt II dated 13.03.2020, vide which result of competitive examination for Direct Recruitment of GDS to Postman/ Mail Guard cadre held on 29.09.2019 was declared. In this exam, two vacancies were earmarked for EWS for vacancy year 2019 (Shimla = 1, Dharamsala = 1). However, due to non-availability of eligible EWS candidates in the aforesaid exam, these posts could not be filled. Therefore, these unfilled vacancies are proposed to be filled from other qualified meritorious candidates of parent Divisions who fulfill eligibility conditions of unreserved posts, in accordance with DOPT OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31.01.2019 which provide that 'Where in any recruitment year any vacancy earmarked for EWS can not be filled up due to non availability of a suitable candidate belongings to EWS, such vacancies for that particular recruitment year shall not be carried forwarded to the next recruitment year as backlog'.

Accordingly, supplementary result of above said examination is here under declared and following candidates are declared successful for appointment as Postman :

The present result is further subject to outcome of court/ CAT cases, correction of clerical mistakes if any. The candidature/ selection of selected candidates is liable to be cancelled if later on it is found that false information has been given by the candidate or candidate was not eligible due to any disciplinary/ criminal case against him/ her. The concerned Divisional/ Unit Head may initiate suitable disciplinary action against such candidates.

Concerned Divisional Head/ Recruiting Unit Head are requested to carry out all required pre-appointment formalities as per prevalent Rules and instructions issued from time to time. Before appointment it should be ensured that no disciplinary case is pending/ contemplated or no penalty is current against the above selected/ promoted candidates.

Training order of above officials will be issued separately as per seat availability in training centers. Divisional Head/ Appointing Authority may issue promotion orders of concerned officials as allotted to their Divisions/ Units.
