ORDER

Subject: Promotion and postings in the Grade of Assistant Director (Recruitment).

Director General Postal Services is pleased to appoint Shri Biswajit Bose, Office Superintendent Grade-I to the post of Assistant Director (Recruitment), General Central Services Group B Gazetted, in the pre-revised scale of PB-2, Rs.9300-34800/- with Grade Pay Rs.4600/- (Level 7 in new Pay Matrix) on regular basis with effect from the date of assumption of charge and until further orders.

2. The posts of Assistant Director (Recruitment) in the Department of Posts are to be filled up on rotation basis and will get transferred to the Circle to which the promoted officer belongs as clarified in the Department's letter No.31-23/91-P.E.-II dated 21.09.2001. The post ceases to operate on retirement on superannuation of the incumbent in the concerned Circle. Accordingly, the officer on promotion to Assistant Director (Recruitment) is allotted to the Circle as follows:

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (iii) In case, the officer is not willing to accept his promotion, his declination letter in writing should be received in Directorate within 30 days of issuing of this order, failing which, it shall be presumed that he has declines the promotion.

4. VIGILANCE/ DISCIPLINARY CASE, IF ANY:



The official against whom any punishment is current except censure and recovery of money, he should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment. A report in this regard be submitted immediately.

If the officer who wishes to give option for choosing date for fixation of pay under FR-22(I)(a)(1) should do so within one month from the date of assumption of charge on promotion.
