Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the letters under reference and the subject cited above and to say that the Competent Authority has accorded its approval for declaration of the results of eligible PwBDs candidates and other candidates for the vacancy years 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023. 3. Personnel Division, Postal Directorate vide letter No. X-20/17/2024-SPN-II dated 19.07.2024 stated [refer para No. 4] that Qualifying marks / relaxed standards being adopted for SC/ST in the Departmental Examination are to be extended to PwBD candidates to fill up the vacancies reserved for PwBD in case reserved vacancies could not be filled up within the normal prescribed standards. Accordingly, the maximum marks and minimum qualifying marks (category-wise) in r/o of each paper and overall average as adopted in LDCE IP for the vacancy years 2019, 2020 & 2021 and LDCE IP for the vacancy years 2022 & 2023 are reproduced as under:

4. Instructions mentioned in Para 13.3 of DoPT OM No. 36012/1/2020-Estt.(Res.-II) dated 17.05.2022 has been taken into account for declaring the results of successful PwBD candidates.

"In order to ensure that cases of lapse of reservation are kept to the minimum, any recruitment of the PwBD candidates shall first be counted against the vacant posts brought forward from pervious years, if any, in the chronological order. If candidates are not available for all the vacancies, the older carried-forward posts shall be filled first, and the current vacancies shall be carried forward, if not filled up provided that in every recruitment, the number of vacancies reserved for PwBD including the carried forward vacancies, shall be announced beforehand, for the information of all aspirants."

5. Personnel Division, Postal Directorate has drawn the following modality to make effect the DoPT OMs dated 17.05.2022 and dated 28.12.2023:

5.1 In the event of non-availability of PwBD candidates for promotion in a particular vacancy year, the vacancy shall be carried forward.

5.2 In the subsequent year, if PwBD of respective category is available, the vacancy shall be filled up with the same category of PwBD candidate. If the same category of PwBD candidate is not available, the vacancy shall be filled up with other category of PwBD candidate who is higher in the merit list.

5.3 If any vacancy of PwBD category remains unfilled in the subsequent year, no such vacancy earmarked for PwBD is to be filled up for that year by a person other than a PwBD. However, reservation shall be carried forward for two subsequent recruitment years, where after it shall lapse.
