Memo No. R&E/2-5/CRC/2023 dated at Bengaluru – 560 001 the 06-01-2025

The Circle Relaxation Committee met on 19-12-2024, 20-12-2024 and 01-01-2025 to consider the requests of dependents of deceased Departmental officials for appointment on compassionate grounds in relaxation of normal Recruitment Rules for Postal Assistants/Sorting Assistants, Postman/Mail Guard and Multi-Tasking Staff posts for the vacancy year 2023.

2. The Committee considered a total of **73 cases** uploaded in Online Compassionate Appointment Portal for the vacancy year 2023. The cases have been examined / considered by the Committee in accordance with the guidelines/consolidated instructions issued vide DoPT OM Nos. (i) 14014/6/14-Estt.(D) dated 09-10-1998, (ii) 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16-01-2013, (iii) FAQ in DoPT OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 30-05-2013, Directorate's clarifications issued vide letter nos. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 20-07-2023, 24-44/2022-SPG-II dated 10-11-2023 and revised relative merit points issued vide (iv) Directorate letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022, Standard Operating Procedure issued vide (v) Directorate letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 24-03-2022 and as per rules and regulations as amended from time to time. The calculation of degree of indigence of each applicant in comparison to other cases received for consideration is done by taking into account all the relevant factors and various attributes.
3. The details of Direct Recruitment quota vacancies in PA/SA, PM/MG and MTS Cadres earmarked for appointment on compassionate grounds are enclosed as **Annexure-I**.
4. Selection to posts has been made according to merit points secured by the candidates, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility conditions.
5. In accordance with the approval of the Competent Authority and recommendations by the CRC, the cases for compassionate appointment which have been recommended / rejected / referred to Next CRC are detailed below :
6. **Thirteen (13)** applicants have been '**RECOMMENDED AND APPROVED**' for appointment on compassionate grounds. The Competent Authority recommended to offer Postal Assistants/Sorting Assistants, Postman/Mail Guard and Multi-Tasking Staff posts to the applicants who came up in the selection zone depending upon the eligibility conditions as per the prevalent Recruitment Rules and merit points secured to the extent of vacancies reserved for compassionate appointment quota. The details of the approved cases and the allotment to the respective Divisions/Units, where the vacancies are earmarked for compassionate appointment are enclosed as **Annexure -II**.
7. **Forty (40)** cases have been '**REFERRED TO THE NEXT CRC**' due to paucity of vacancies. The details of the cases are enclosed in **Annexure-III**.
8. **Twenty (20)** cases have been '**REJECTED**' for the reasons shown against each case. The details of the cases are enclosed in **Annexure-IV**.
9. **In view of the allotment of approved candidates (Annexure-II) under compassionate grounds, following instructions are issued:**

In respect of Postal Assistant/Sorting Assistant, Postman/Mailguard and MTS cadres, allotment should be adjusted against the vacancies already reserved in Direct Recruitment quota for the vacancy year 2023. The Regional Heads/Unit Heads are requested to issue suitable instructions to the concerned Divisional / Unit Heads concerned.
10. The Postal Directorate vide letter no. 24-2/88-SPB-I dated 18-11-1991 and no. 37-4/2013-SPB-I/C dated 12-06-2013 informs that "once the candidate has accepted an appointment

to a particular post on compassionate grounds, the set of circumstances which led to his initial appointment should be deemed to have ceased to exist and thereafter the person who has accepted compassionate appointment in a particular post should strive in his career like his colleagues for further advancement and claims for appointment to higher post on consideration of compassion should invariably be rejected”.

- 11(i). The applicant who has the higher qualifications but offered with lower posts like Postman/Multi-Tasking Staff posts due to paucity of vacancies in Postal Assistant/Sorting Assistant cadre may be informed that claims for appointment to higher post on consideration of compassion will not be considered. A declaration to this effect may be obtained & kept on record & a copy of declaration should be sent to Circle office.
- 11(ii). The allotment of applicants has been made to the same /nearest division as far as possible. Hence, no requests for change of posting / divisions will be entertained. **While issuing posting orders, efforts should be made by the concerned Division / Unit to accommodate the selected applicant near his / her place of residence to enable him/her to take care of the family.**
12. The following clause/conditions may invariably be included in the provisional appointment order to be issued to the applicant(s) selected for appointment on compassionate grounds and a declaration /undertaking should be obtained and kept on service records /service book.
- I. That if any of the fact mentioned are found to be incorrect or false at a future date, his/her services are liable to be terminated at any point of time without issue of any notice. This memo will be considered as the advance notice.
 - II. That he/she shall maintain properly the other family members who were dependents on Government servant and in case it is proved at any time that the said family members are being neglected or not being properly maintained by him/her, his/her appointment is liable to be terminated at any point of time without issue of any notice. This memo will be considered as the advance notice.
 - III. That he/she will give in the declaration that he/she will abide by the rules and regulations issued by DoP&T and DOP as amended from time to time.
13. If the selected applicant is in receipt of family pension, the office of payment of family pension must be informed suitably.
- 14(i). As per the existing Recruitment Rules for PA/SA Cadre, 2022 the applicant should have Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University or Institute and knowledge of working on computer.
- 14(ii). As per Recruitment Rules of Postman Cadre, 2018 the applicant should be 12th/PUC pass from a recognized Board, should have studied Local Language i.e., Kannada upto 10th /SSLC standard, possess knowledge of working on computer and possess a valid Driving License of two wheeler or light motor vehicle. Therefore, the applicant who has been selected for the post of Postman should possess computer knowledge and also should acquire Driving License to drive two wheeler within a period of two years from the date of candidate appointment, as per Postman/Mail guard Recruitment (Amendments) Rules, 2020.
- 14(iii). As per Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2023 prevalent for Postman/Mail Guard Cadre, the educational qualification required is 12th Standard pass from a recognised Board,

subject to conditions mentioned in RR, possess knowledge of working on computer and possess a valid Driving License of two wheeler or Light Motor Vehicle.

- 14(iv). As per Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2023 of Multi Tasking Staff Cadre, the educational qualification required for the applicant is 10th standard pass from a recognised Board and should have studied local language at least upto 10th Standard.
15. **As per point no. 31 of FAQs issued by DoP&T vide OM no. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 30-05-2013, “A person selected for appointment on compassionate grounds should be adjusted in the recruitment roster against the appropriate category viz SC/ST/OBC/General depending upon the category to which he belongs”. Hence, the Divisional / Unit Head should obtain the respective caste certificate from the approved applicants, get the caste certificate verified and accordingly adjust the community of the applicant in the recruitment roster.**
- 16(I) Following instructions issued by DoP&T should be followed while issuing provisional appointment order to the selected candidates :
1. As per para no. 3 of DoPT OM No. 18011/2(s)/2016-Estt.(B)(i) dated 29-06-2016, it is stated that, ***“It has been decided that now the verification of character & antecedents will be carried out, but the issue of appointment letters need not be withheld pending such verification. The appointing authorities will issue provisional appointment letters after obtaining the attestation form and self declaration from the candidate. The candidate along with the details of attestation form will also submit the self-declaration certifying that all facts and details given in the form are correct.”***
 2. As per para no. 4 of above DoPT OM it has further been stated that, ***“in the provisional appointment letter, it will be clearly mentioned that in case character & antecedents of the candidate is found not verified or any false information is given by the candidate in his / her self-declaration, the provisional appointment letter will be cancelled henceforth and other criminal / legal action will also be taken, as a consequence”***.
 3. Similar instructions have been issued for verification of SC/ST caste certificates in DoPT OM dated 14-03-2016 wherein under para no. 2 it is stated that, ***“..... has reiterated the instructions on providing provisional appointment to such reserved category candidates who are unable to obtain an appropriate caste certificate in time”***.
- 16(II) Apropos to the above DoPT instructions, as the appointment on compassionate grounds is also through “Direct Recruitment”, these instructions apply for issue of immediate provisional appointment orders to the applicants selected through compassionate grounds.
- 16(III) The applicants selected through compassionate appointment should be requested to submit all the relevant documents / educational qualification certificates / caste certificates / medical fitness form / character and antecedent forms etc., as part of pre-appointment formalities and on satisfaction that all the documents have been submitted, the concerned Division / Region / Unit can issue “Provisional Appointment” order to such applicants with the above mentioned DoPT clauses and thereafter carry out the genuineness of the documents submitted by the applicants from the concerned authorities. This will avoid delay in joining of the applicants in the selected post / cadre.
- 16(IV) If any of the fact mentioned by the applicant are found to be incorrect or false at a future date / any fake certificates detected at any point of time, the service of the applicant will

be terminated without any prior notice. This memo will be considered as the advance notice.

- 16(V) That he/she will give in the declaration that he/she will abide by the rules and regulations issued by DoP&T and DOP as amended from time to time.
17. If any applicant is found ineligible, he/she should not be appointed, but the matter should be reported to this office immediately.
18. **The Postal Directorate vide letter no. 17-5/2020-SPG-II dated 22-03-2021 has directed to conduct typing test for the applicants below the age of 45 years who have been appointed as Postman/ PA/SA cadres on compassionate grounds. Further, the concerned Regional Heads should conduct the Typing Test as per the clarifications issued by Directorate in letter no. SG-17/22/2024-SPG-II-DOP dated 12-12-2024.**
19. A copy of this Memo should be pasted in the Service books of the recommended and approved applicants on their appointments.
20. **All the Divisions / Units are directed to address all the applicants individually about the recommendations of the CRC and approval of the Competent Authority ie., whether their cases are recommended, rejected and referred to next CRC. This office will not issue individual letters to the applicants.**
