Sub:- Promotion to the post of PS Group B on the basis of supplementary result of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination held on 3rd June 2012 for the vacancy year 2012.

On the basis of supplementary result of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination held on 3rd June 2012 for the vacancy year 2012, declared by DE Branch of the Postal Directorate vide letter No. A-34013/03/2012-DE dated 26.02.2018 in pursuance of Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 10.10.2017 in SLP No. 24725/2017, the Director General (Posts) has approved the promotion of the following General line official to Postal Service Group 'B' cadre on regular basis in the Pay Band of Rs.9300-34800/- in Grade Pay Rs. 5400 (pre-revised) (level 9 in the pay matrix as per 7th CPC) with effect from the date of assumption of charge of the post and until further orders.

2. The officer on promotion to Postal Service Group 'B' grade is allotted to the Circle mentioned against his name:

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- i. No re-allotment requests will be considered within a period of one year. Leave taken during this period will not be counted for calculation of one-year period for considering requests for re-allotments.
- ii. Appointment is conditional to the officer's placement in the designated circle.
- iii. It is the officer's responsibility to send a copy of the charge report on assumption of charge on the promoted post to Director (Staff) for record purpose.
- iv. Officer should be relieved within 30 days from the date of issue of this order.
- v. In case, the officer is not willing to accept his promotion, his declination letter in writing should be received in the Directorate within 30 days of this order, failing which, it will be presumed that he has declined the promotion.

4. VIGILANCE/DISCIPLINARY CASE, IF ANY:

In case any vig./disc. case, of the type referred to in O.M. No. 22011/2/86-Estt. (A) dated 12.01.88 from DOP&T circulated vide this office memo No. 25-19/88-SPG dated 04.05.88 (subsequently) revised vide DOP&T memo No. 22022/4/91-Estt.(A) dated 14.09.92 circulated vide this office memo no. 25-19/88-SPG dated 13.10.92 is pending against the official, he should not be relieved for posting on promotion without obtaining specific orders from this Directorate. The official against whom any punishment is current, should not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment. A report in this regard be submitted to the Postal Directorate immediately.

5. PROBATION PERIOD:

The official promoted to the Postal Service Group 'B' will be on probation for two years and then his suitability to hold this post will be adjudged on completion of two years of probation. If the official proceeds on leave for a period exceeding 30 days during this period, the probation period will be extended depending upon the period of leave.

6. OPTION FOR FIXATION OF PAY:

The officer who wishes to give option for choosing the date for fixation of pay under FR-22(I)(a)(1) should do so within one month from the date of promotion.
