Subject: - Merger of non-technical posts in independent units such as PSFS, PSDs, CSDs, PTCs, RAKNPA etc.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to Directorate's communication number of even number dated 12.04.2019 vide which non-technical posts in independent units such as PSFS, PSDs, CSDs, PTCs, RAKNPA etc. was added to the sanctioned strength of corresponding level posts of the Postal Division, which is covering the geographical area in which such independent establishment is located. References were received from Postal Circles pointing out some difficulties and seeking clarifications. The references have been examined and clarified as under: -

| Sl. No. | Clarification Sought | Comments / Remarks |

| 1. | If posts of CSD / PSD included in sanctioned strength of Postal division, same will be included in gradation list of the Division or not. | As per above mentioned order dated 12.04.2019, sanctioned strength of CSD and such isolated units have to be merged with sanctioned strength of the Postal Division, which is covering geographical area in which CSD / isolated unit is located. Therefore, gradation list of the Division shall also include non-technical posts of CSD / isolated units. |
| 2. | Whether transfer / posting of the officials will be made only in CSD or any other offices falling under the jurisdiction of Postal Division. | The aforesaid order also provides that Postal Division shall be the feeder Division for recruiting / posting of staff on tenure basis. Hence, transfer / posting of staff, belonging to non-technical cadres which are merged with Postal Division, can be made in or out of CSD / isolated unit. |



| 3. | After merger, who will be the controlling authority of PSD & CSD. | CPMG of the concerned Circle may decide. |
| 4. | Any other official (other than CSD staff) working under the designated Division is to be eligible for transfer in CSD or not | After merger, non-technical staff of CSD / isolated unit will come under the jurisdiction / control of Division. Therefore, officials working under the designated Division are eligible for transfer in CSD in the posts belonging to non-technical cadre only. |
| 5. | Separate vacancies will be maintained for CSD and designated Division. | After the merger of non-technical posts in CSD / isolated units with the respective Postal Divisions, vacancies of these non-technical posts will be maintained by designated Division. |
