Memo. No. Rectt/2-4/LGO Exam /2019 dated at Dehradun the 20.04.2020

In continuation to this office memo of even no. dated 12.02.2020, the following candidates were declared surplus qualified in the Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) from Postman/Mail Guard and MTS for recruitment to the cadre of PA/SA for the vacancies of the year 2019 held on 15.09.2019 followed by Data Entry Skill Test on 09.02.2020 on the basis of marks secured in Paper-I, since Paper-II and III were only qualifying nature. Their preferences were called for with a view of their allotment in the Division with unfilled vacancies.

2. Now, the Competent Authority is pleased to declare the result of following 04 surplus candidates who have been selected in the Examination for Recruitment from Postman, Mail Guard and MTS to the cadre of PA/SA for the vacancies of the year 2019 held on 15.09.2019 followed by Data Entry Skill Test held on 09.02.2020 on the basis of available unfilled category wise Division wise vacancies in order of merit in Paper I as follows:-

3. The selection of the candidates is subject to the provisions of relevant RRs and other conditions (Pattern and Syllabus) laid down for recruitment of LGOs to PA/SA cadre through LDCE. The Divisional heads will issue appointment to the candidates selected in Para 2 in the format prescribed by the Directorate. They, before issuing appointment to the candidates will check the result with reference to their recommendations and other criteria and ensure that their selection is correct as per the recommendations and the conditions/criteria for qualifying the Exam. In case, any discrepancy is found, they will not issue the appointment and will bring the discrepancy promptly to the notice of this office confidentially. The Divisional heads will issue appointment of the candidates selected in after fulfilling the pre appointment formalities as prescribed by the Directorate from time to time.

4. In case, any candidate is not willing for promotion as PA/SA, then his/her refusal should be sent to this office within 07 days.

5. The details of the candidates has been shown as per the list provided by the division. If however, it any mistake in the Name/Roll number/community of the candidate is noticed, the same may be corrected and intimated to this office immediately.

6. Before issuance of appointment order to be the selected candidates, the Divisional Head concerned should match the photograph of the candidate allowed to appear in the examination with the videography clips recorded during the examination.

The Division Head before issuing appointment to the official should ensure that no vigilance/disciplinary case is either pending or contemplated against him/her and no punishment like stoppage of increment is current against the official. In case, there is any such case, the official concerned may not be promoted and the facts be reported to this offices immediately.
