4. In pursuance of Directorate guidelines contained in letter No.17-08/2018-SPB-I dated 10.05.2019, the candidates who qualify in in Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III separately shall be considered for final selection and their merit shall be drawn in order of marks secured in Paper-I since both Paper-II and Paper-III (DEST) are qualifying in nature. Rules 2022 PA/SA cadres notified in GST 459 (E) dated 17.06.2022, communicated vide Directorate letter No.04-05/2015-SPN-I dated 20.06.2022 and in pursuance of Directorate letter No.X-12/6/2021-SPN-II dated 31.12.2021, a single merit list at circle level with the successful candidates of the above LDCE has been prepared and the selected candidates have been allotted to the Divisions/Units as per merit (Category-wise i.e. UR, SC & ST) vis a vis order of preference exercised by the candidates subject of availability of vacancies in the Divisions/Units.

5. Result of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) for promotion of Postman/Mail Guard/MTS to the cadre of Postal Assistants/ Sorting Assistants is annexed as Annexure-I.


6. Divisions/Units are requested to verify the relevant particulars of the selected candidates on their own level, before issue of promotion orders. In case, it is subsequently found that any of the selected candidate(s) was not eligible to take the examination under the extant rules or instructions on the subject for any other reasons or in case any mistake is found with regard to announcement of result of any candidate for any reason whatsoever, the same may be brought to the notice of Circle Office, Bhubaneswar immediately, so that his/her name could be deleted from the list of successful candidates. This should be incorporated in the promotion/appointment letters issued.

7. In Directorate letter No.04-08/2019-SPN-I dated 11.12.2020, detailed guidelines on deciding of inter-se rank/merit in case of more than one candidate scoring equal mark in departmental examination/DR recruitment examination have been issued. In case where two or more candidates of the same Division/ Unit and of same substantive cadre get clubbed due to securing equal marks, the Divisional Gradation List has been taken into account for this purpose.

8. Provisional Candidates: The Heads of the concerned Divisions/Units are requested to immediately finalise the provisional candidature and such cases should not be kept pending for long time, so that the provisional candidates may not have to wait for the result inordinately. If name of any provisionally permitted candidate is found in the list of selected candidates, the same may be brought to the notice of Circle Office, Bhubaneswar for immediate necessary action. It is informed that the names of the candidates have been arranged in the order of merit. In respect of candidates who got equal marks in the total, Divisions/Units are requested to arrange their position in the merit list according to their inter se seniority/instructions on the subject and intimate the same to Recruitment Section of the Circle Office, Bhubaneswar. It may also be ensured that no provisional candidate, even if found in the list of selected candidates, shall be given promotion/appointment under any circumstances without regularization of his/her candidature.

9. Applications under RTI Act for supply of photocopies of OMR Answer Sheets will be entertained in the following manner:

- (a) Candidates, who wish to have the copies of OMR Answer Sheets supplied, are required to remit a fee of Rs.2/- per page + Rs.10/- towards fee for application under RTI Act and submit their applications to CPIO-cum-Asst. Director (RE), Circle Office Bhubaneswar.
- (b) A copy of this letter with annexures have been uploaded on [www.odishapost.gov.in](http://www.odishapost.gov.in) and [www.indiapost.gov.in](http://www.indiapost.gov.in). Requests for supply of these documents under RTI Act will not be entertained.
