2. Vigilance/Disciplinary Case, if any:

2.2 In case any punishment is current except censure the officer shall not be promoted before expiry of currency of punishment in terms of DoPT's OM No. 22034/5/2004-Estt. (D) dated 15.12.2004. A report, if any, in this regard may be submitted immediately to ADG (SPG), Department of Posts, New Delhi- 110 001. In case period of punishment is reduced/ increased due to revision in punishment order of the officer, promotion order shall be issued on the expiry of revised period of punishment, only after prior permission of this office.

3. The officer shall be relieved immediately with the directions to join his place of posting on promotion without any delay and his charge reports may be sent to Directorate in due course.

4. The appointment made on ad-hoc basis, will not bestow upon the officer any claim for regular appointment and the service rendered on ad-hoc basis in the grade would not count for the purpose of seniority in that grade or eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade.
